- Make export it.education S/4
- Test upgrade existing customers

Attention points

- Similar for a university who has been developing on SLcM for many years
- Continue to keep it.education future proof
 - Started Code retirement
 - Started Reducing modifications in SAP objects
 - Standardizing naming conventions
- Cleaning up old-unwanted customizing
- Maintenance and Support strategy for both new as existing it.education customers
- Fiori tiles have to be compatible with an embedded and stand alone gateway strategy
- No need to move to S/4HANA for Fiori and CDS views only

Move it.education to S/4HANA: Risk Areas (I)

- Business partners
- Possible risk: High
- Business Partner Migration (CVI)
 - Mandatory for S/4HANA
 - You can implement this at any given time
 - Supported since years
 - Conversion tools are standard available
- Changes GL account(Finance) depending on the functions the customer needs
 - No need of any functions \rightarrow no New GL sub project necessary
 - Need S/4HANA Finance functions \rightarrow check if it is possible to activate them after the Conversion
- Attention points:
 - System cleanup needed (More checks in BP then customer/vendor)
 - Archiving of historical data
 - Alignment student –business partner (note 2647172)
- Conclusion: Impact for internal it.education systems was low
 - Big impact for existing customers. Pre-project impact analyses required

Move it.education to S/4HANA: Risk Areas (II)

Optimized data model

Who has experimented with this?



Move it.education to S/4HANA: Risk Areas (II)

- Optimized data model (Who is using this?)
- Possible risk: Very high
- Activation is not mandatory. Not a reversible switch!!!
- SAP standard transformation checks do not require this model to be activated.
- Conclusion: Functional testing is succes without activation.
- Relevance for (future) activating is topic of discussion. (added value?)
 - Direct link between student and program (technical)
 - Changes multiple tables to 1 table
 - Conversion: No delete in original tables with standard program

Move it.education to S/4HANA: Risk Areas (III)

- BRF (Post processing framework in SLcM)
- Possible risk: Very high
- it.education/ standard SIcM just uses one Application Class
 - Has proven to be still useable on an S/4HANA -system.
 - Modifications and additions to this class can be made as before.
- Still works (No official end of live)
- Conclusion: no impact and optimization is to move to BRF plus
- Optimization: Move to BRF plus with release strategy (if touched then changed)

	Do not create a new application class in the BRF. Instead, generate a BRFplus application.
	Convert an application that is already using the BRF to the BRFplus.
	You must complete this activity before you switch to SAP S/4HANA Cloud Edition.

Move it.education to S/4HANA: Risk Areas (IV)

- Fiori apps
 - Possible risk: Medium
 - SLcM standard fiori Apps are affected (next slide)
 - S/4HANA functionality is for optimization later:
 - Notifications
 - UI5 1.65 (Fiori 3.0) with new theme
 - Embedded and separate gateway was tested
 - Conclusion: Possible to deploy existing apps. Extensions have to move to new _S4 apps

Move it.education to S/4HANA: Risk Areas



Move it.education to S/4HANA: Risk Areas (V)

- Output management
- Possible risk: low
- Is Optional in SAP S/4HANA on premise
- No SLcM specific functionality
- Coexists with other frameworks (smartforms, sapscript, ...)
- Conclusion: No impact for now, optimization later

Move it.education to S/4HANA: Risk Areas (VI)

- Simplification Check
 - Possible risk: High
- Simplification checks seem to be very positive.
- Itelligence tools available for custom code check
- Conclusion: Standard sap tool + solutions/proposed steps work very well and solved our issues.

 - Existing interfacing with PI was tested
 - New possibilities are for optimization
 - Conclusion: No direct impact for our solution, lots of possibilities (SCP, HCI, API manager, ...)
